

## **Pinckneyville High School Bass Fishing Team**

### ISHA Competition Participant Selection Criteria

1. Introduction:

This document will outline the method(s) used to identify the students who will represent Pinckneyville Community High School in the IHSA sanctioned bass fishing tournaments.

2. Eligibility:

For a student to be eligible for participation in this activity, they must comply with existing PCHS and IHSA criteria concerning eligibility for such activities.

3. Team members:

All active participants of the PCHS Bass fishing club will be considered for selection to represent PCHS in the IHSA sanctioned tournaments.

Active members are defined by students who enroll in the club and make a genuine effort to participate in club meetings and club tournaments.

IHSA has allowed for the selection of two competitive teams per school, and the selection of two alternate anglers to be used for substitutions to the existing teams. Competitive teams will consist of two anglers per team.

4. Selection Criteria:

Anglers selected for the competition teams will be selected on the following basis:

- a. Competitive anglers will be selected based on the previous year's performance in the PCHS Bass Club tournaments. Anglers will be selected from the AoY (Anglers of the Year )points list. The top six anglers in the PCHS Bass Club AoY list will be the group from which the anglers competing in the IHSA tournaments will be selected.
- b. In the case of a tie, ties will be broken by calculating the total number of fish weighed in by the angler during the PCHS Bass Club tournaments. Should a second tie breaker be needed, the total weight accumulated during club tournaments for the year will be the second tie breaking criteria. The angler with the highest weight total will be selected. Should there continue to be a tie; it will be left up to the coaches to arrive at a consensus decision on which angler to select.
- c. All reigning and past Anglers of the Year (AoY) can be considered for selection to the competitive teams provided eligibility requirements are met. This is based solely on the discretion of the coaches.
- d. If competitive teams are not completely selected by the use of the above criteria, the team coaches will use their best discretion in selecting club anglers to compete on the team.
