The Board of Education of Pinckneyville Community High School District #101, Perry County, Illinois, met in a regular session on the 28th of September, 2015 at 6:30 p.m. at the Pinckneyville Community High School in that district. Keith Hagene, Superintendent, Penny Corn, recording secretary, and Dustin Foutch, principal, were also present.

Dutch Ferrero agreed with Shirley and feels he was not given the opportunity to vote whether bonds should be sold, and feels the amount is too high.

Mr. Waggoner gave an athletic report on fall sports programs.

Mr. Hagene relayed the information concerning the Consolidated Grain and Barge Fall Harvest Program in which PCHS will be given one cent per every bushel of grain sold to them by area farmers who to designate the PCHS FFA Chapter as beneficiary.
