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SAT

All PCHS Juniors will be required to take the SAT with Essay as part of Illinois State testing. This test will be on April 9, 2019.

The SAT and ACT are offered on National Test Dates throughout the year. PCHS will be giving the SAT on Saturday, December 1, 2018. The cost is \$47.50 and \$64.50 with essay. You can register for the test at www.collegeboard.org. You can find a list of ACT dates and locations at www.act.org. Khan Academy offers free online test prep for the SAT.

Dual Credit/Dual Enrollment

- Juniors and Seniors can obtain college credit through Rend Lake College while you are still in High School. Currently, PCHS is offering College Algebra, Trigonometry, Calculus, English 1101, English 1102, Ag Business Management, Ag Science, & Spanish IV as **dual credit**. As a senior, you can take, Psychology, Child Psychology, Sociology, Biology, and Music Appreciation at the Murphy Wall Campus in the afternoons if you meet the placement requirements. Other **Dual Enrollment** courses are available after the regular school day at the Murphy Wall campus during the Fall, Spring, & Summer semesters. Students must pay half of the tuition rate to take **Dual Enrollment** Courses. Dual Credit courses continue to have only a \$10 fee per book.
