Graduation Requirements

28 Credits Required for Graduation

1. Four (4) credits in English/Reading
2. Three (3) credits in Math
3. Three (3) credits in Science
4. Three (3) credits in Social Studies
5. Four (4) credits in PE, .5 Credits in Health
6. .5 Credit of Resource Management
7. One (1) Credit of Career Technical Education
8. One (1) Credit of Fine Arts
9. 20 Hours of Community Service (5/year)

Off Campus Lunch

Remember, you must stay on campus for lunch unless you are on the Good Grade Incentive list that comes out on Monday. If you do not have any grade lower than a "B" when grades are checked that Monday, you will be able to leave every day that week for lunch. CHECK THE LIST! (Must have permission slip on file)
